 - At least one of the founders has an African nationality.

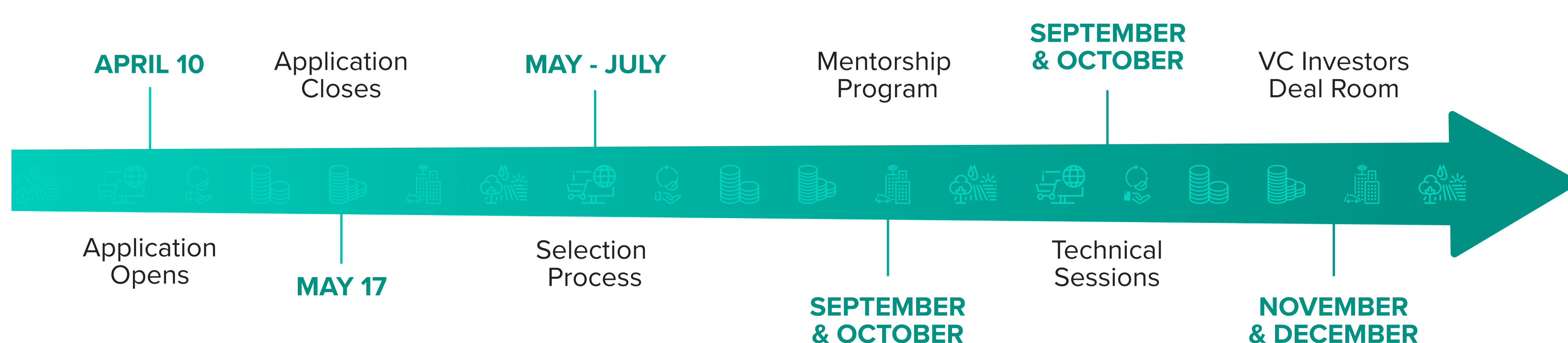
